FPT TRUCK BOOKING SYSTEM | *Terms and Conditions*

- Trucks that do not arrive within their booked time slot, will be serviced on the next available time slot.
- 2. Drivers to report to the office with their documents on arrival at the truck stop.
- **3.** All drivers to be attired in the correct/relevant PPE.
- **4.** Once trucks are dispatched from the truck stop to the offloading depot, trucks ensure they go directly to the offloading depot, with no deviated routes.
- **5.** At the offloading points driver to report to the Intake Office with their documents and truck stop dispatch slip as well as attired in the correct PPE.
- **6.** Bookings will be accommodated only if a time slot is available.
- **7.** Transporters, Drivers and vehicles are not insured by FPT for any risk or loss or injury whilst utilizing truck stop services.
- 8. All services used at your own risk.
- 9. Drivers to remain in vehicles whilst awaiting dispatch instructions.
- 10. Only confirmed loads must be booked.
- **11.** Once all slots are filled any trucks arriving at truck stop without a slot booking will be considered as unbooked.
- **12.** Slot times are only for control purposes and are influenced by seasonality of exports & shipping.
- 13. Transporter to ensure that the truck has a valid Harbor Carriers Permit issued by the Transnet National Ports Authority (TNPA). Without this, the truck will not be allowed to enter the port area.
